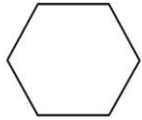
Dear Family,

My class started Chapter 12 this week. In this chapter, I will describe and combine two-dimensional shapes. I will learn about equal shares, halves, and fourths.

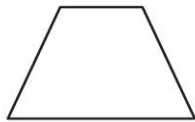
